* 세미나를 제안하며

- 시민건강증진연구소는 2017년 3월부터 ‘지역 경제위기와 건강영향’ 연구를 진행합니다. 이 연구는 특정 산업 의존도가 높은 일부 지역에서 산업침체가 가져온 경제위기, 그로부터 초래되는 건강과 사회적 안녕의 문제를 기술하고 설명하는 데 초점을 두고 있습니다.
- 이 연구의 일환으로 [공장폐쇄, 탈산업화의 지역사회 영향]이라는 제목으로 1차 세미나를 시작합니다 (이후 관련 세미나 시리즈가 이어질 예정입니다). 선행 연구들로부터 지역 경제위기에 따른 고용환경과 소득의 변화, 개인/지역수준에서의 의료 이용과 건강행동, 건강결과에 미치는 영향과 경로를 검토하는 것이 세미나의 목표입니다. 특히 한국 사회보다 앞서 유사한 지역 경제위기를 겪었던 영국과 호주, 미국 등의 사례에 초점을 둘 예정입니다.
